# The Social Security Benefits Uprating Order (Northern Ireland) 2005

#### **PART II**

### SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS AND PENSIONS

#### Rates or amounts of certain benefits under the Pension Schemes Act

- **5.**—(1) It is hereby directed that the sums specified in paragraph (2) shall be increased from and including the respective dates specified in Article 6.
- (2) Sums which are payable by virtue of section 11(1) of the Pension Schemes Act (increase of guaranteed minimum where commencement of guaranteed minimum pension is postponed) to a person who is also entitled to a Category A or Category B retirement pension (including sums payable by virtue of section 13(2) of that Act) shall be increased by
  - (a) 3·1 per cent. of their amount apart from this Order where the increase under section 11(1) is attributable to earnings factors for the tax year 1987-88 and earlier tax years(1); and
  - (b) 0.1 per cent. of their amount apart from this Order where the increase under section 11(1) is attributable to earnings factors for the tax years 1988-89 to 1996-97 inclusive.
