The Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30(1) of the Health and Social Care (Reform) Act (Northern Ireland) 2009(1):

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Health and Social Care (Reform) (2009 Act) (Consequential Provisions) Order (Northern Ireland) 2009 and shall come into operation on 1st April 2009.

(2) In this Order—

"the Order" means the Nursing and Midwifery Order 2001(2).

Amendment to Schedule 4 of the Order

2. In Schedule 4 of the Order (Interpretation), in paragraph (c) of the definition of "local supervising authority" for "Health and Social Services Boards;" substitute "the Regional Agency for Public Health and Social Well-being;".
