**Superannuation (Health and Social Care Bodies) Order
(Northern Ireland) 2009**

Made - - - - - *3rd April 2009*

Coming into operation - *24th April 2009*

The Department of Finance and Personnel makes the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 3(4) and (7) of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(a) and now vested in it(b).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Health and Social Care Bodies) Order (Northern Ireland) 2009 and shall come into operation on 24th April 2009.

Additions to list of employments

2. There shall be added to the employments listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 with effect from 1st April 2009, employment in—

- (a) the Regional Health and Social Care Board(c);
- (b) the Regional Agency for Public Health and Social Well-being(d); and
- (c) the Regional Business Services Organisation(e).

It has retrospective effect by virtue of Article 3(7) of that Order.
