# PART II

### Measures in a surveillance zone

## Cleansing vehicles

- 2.—(1) Vehicles and equipment used within the surveillance zone to transport—
  - (a) pigs, or
- (b) other livestock or material which may be contaminated with swine vesicular disease virus, may not leave the surveillance zone without having been cleansed and disinfected in such a way as to minimise the risk of spread of swine vesicular disease virus.
- (2) In the case of a livestock vehicle the cleansing and disinfection shall be in accordance with Schedule 2 to the Transport of Animals and Poultry (Cleansing and Disinfection) Order (Northern Ireland) 2007.
  - (3) In all other cases, the person in charge of the vehicle shall at least—
    - (a) cleanse and disinfect its wheels, wheel arches and mud flaps; and
    - (b) ensure that the exterior of the vehicle is not visibly contaminated with mud, faeces or other material that might carry swine vesicular disease virus.
- (4) This paragraph does not apply in relation to vehicles travelling through the surveillance zone without stopping.
