Regulation 2(1)

DEFINITION OF RELEVANT FEED LAW

“relevant feed law” means —

- (a) Part IV of the Agriculture Act 1970(1) in so far as it applies in relation to feeding stuffs;
- (b) the Feeding Stuff (Sampling and Analysis) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1999(2);
- (c) the Genetically Modified Animal Feed Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2004(3);
- (d) the Food Hygiene Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006(4) in so far as they apply in relation to feed;
- (e) the Feed (Hygiene and Enforcement) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2005(5); and
- (f) the Feeding Stuff Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2005 (6).
