# JUSTICE

The Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2004 (Commencement No.4) Order 2010

Made - - - - 15th March 2010

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2004(1), makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2004 (Commencement No.4) Order 2010.

**2.** The following provisions of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2004 shall come into force on 12th April 2010—

- (a) section 8(9) (Guidance for criminal justice organisations on human rights standards);
- (b) section 18 (Repeals), to the extent necessary to bring into force the provisions of Schedule 4 listed in paragraph (c);
- (c) in Schedule 4 (Repeals), the entry in respect of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2002(2) in so far as it is not already in force.
