# The Additional Paternity Leave Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010

### PART 4

Provisions applicable to both types of additional paternity leave

### Application of terms and conditions during additional paternity leave

- 27.—(1) During the period of additional paternity leave, P—
  - (a) is entitled to the benefit of all of the terms and conditions of employment which would have applied if P had not been absent, and
  - (b) is bound by any obligations arising under those terms and conditions, subject only to the exception in Article 112C(1)(b) of the 1996 Order(1).
- (2) In paragraph (1)(a), "terms and conditions of employment" has the meaning given by Article 112C(5) of the 1996 Order, and accordingly does not include terms and conditions about remuneration.
- (3) For the purposes of Article 112C of the 1996 Order, only sums payable to P by way of wages or salary are to be treated as remuneration.
- (4) In the case of accrual of rights under an employment-related benefit scheme within the meaning given by paragraph 7 of Schedule 5 to the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1989(2), nothing in paragraph (1)(a) shall be taken to impose a requirement which exceeds the requirements of paragraph 5A of that Schedule.
