**The Welfare Reform (2010 Act) (Commencement No. 1
and Transitory Provision) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010**

Appointed days

2.—(1) The day appointed for the coming into operation of section 13 of the Act (mobility component) is—

- (a) 23rd September 2010, for the purpose only of conferring power to make regulations;
- (b) 15th October 2010, for the purposes only of assessing claims and making decisions on eligibility; and
- (c) 11th April 2011 for all other purposes.

(2) 23rd September 2010 is the day appointed for the coming into operation of—

- (a) section 10 of the Act (power to direct claimant to undertake specific work-related activity);
- (b) section 21 of the Act (repeal of sections 53 to 57 of the Child Support, Pensions and Social Security Act (Northern Ireland) 2000⁽¹⁾);
- (c) the entries in Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the Act (social security: other repeals) in respect of—
 - (i) section 149(5) of the Social Security Administration (Northern Ireland) Act 1992⁽²⁾, paragraph (af) of the definition of “the relevant enactments”;
 - (ii) paragraph 3(e) of Schedule 3 to the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1998⁽³⁾;
 - (iii) the Child Support, Pensions and Social Security Act (Northern Ireland) 2000;
 - (iv) the Social Security Fraud Act (Northern Ireland) 2001⁽⁴⁾;
 - (v) the State Pension Credit Act (Northern Ireland) 2002⁽⁵⁾; and
 - (vi) paragraphs 13 and 14(3) of Schedule 3 to the Welfare Reform Act (Northern Ireland) 2007⁽⁶⁾.
- (d) section 34(1) of the Act (repeals) so far as relating to the entries in sub-paragraph (c).
