**The Crossbill Place, Lisburn (Footpaths) (Abandonment) Order
(Northern Ireland) 2011**

Made - - - - - *27th October 2011*

Coming into operation - *7th December 2011*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 8 to, the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes to abandon the areas of footpath described in the Schedule as they are not necessary.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Crossbill Place, Lisburn (Footpaths) (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011 and shall come into operation on 7th December 2011.

Application

2. The areas of footpath described in the Schedule are abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus owned by BT Telecommunications plc placed along, across, over or under the abandoned areas of footpath shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

4.—(1) All other existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned areas of footpath shall be removed.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be extinguished.

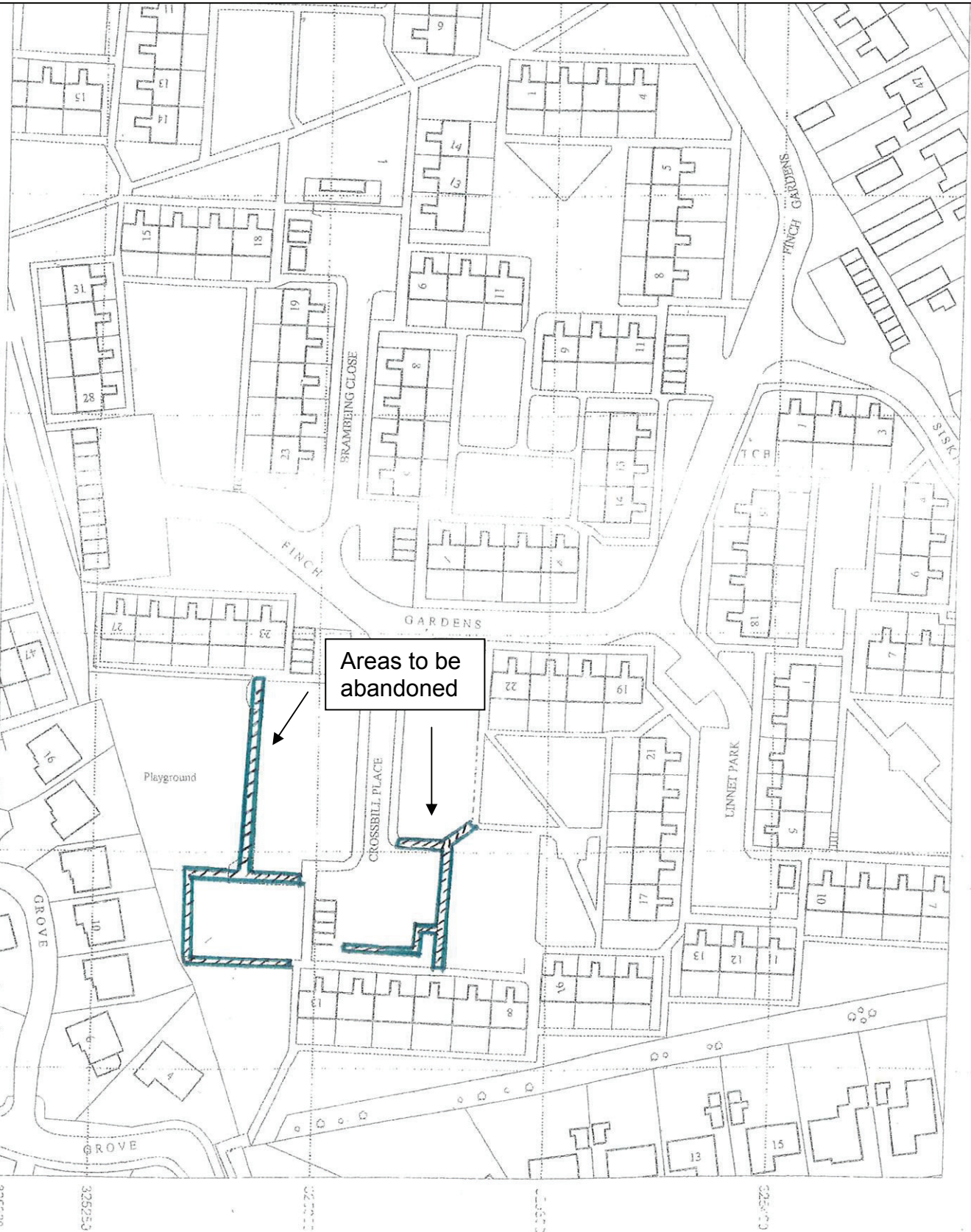
