**The Grange Lodge, Antrim (Abandonment) Order (Northern
Ireland) 2012**

Made - - - - *8th March 2012*

Coming into operation - *2nd May 2012*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes to abandon the areas of road described in the Schedule as they are not necessary.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Grange Lodge, Antrim (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 and shall come into operation on 2nd May 2012.

Application

2. The areas of road described in the Schedule are abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

Article 2

AREAS OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

Two areas of road at Grange Lodge, Antrim totalling 72 square metres, consisting of:—

- (a) 24 square metres of road, on the north side of Grange Lodge, to the front of No. 8; and
- (b) 48 square metres of road, on the south side of Grange Lodge to the front of Nos. 15 and 16;

more particularly delineated and shown cross-hatched on Map No. 10/1/26/11.

A copy of the map has been deposited at the Department's Roads Service offices, Headquarters, Room 213, Clarence Court, 10-18 Adelaide Street, Belfast; and Northern Division, County Hall, Castlerock Road, Coleraine and Antrim Section office, Crown Buildings, Castle Street, Antrim.
