The Loading Bays on Roads (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013

Made---2nd May 2013Coming into operation-23rd May 2013

The Department for Regional Development(\mathbf{a}) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4) and 13(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(\mathbf{b}) and now vested in it(\mathbf{c}).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the road specified in Article 2.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department, in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule has taken such other steps as appear to it reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Loading Bays on Roads (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013 and shall come into operation on 23rd May 2013.

2. The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007(**d**) shall be amended by the addition to Schedule 2 of the following items—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007 ("the Order") by the addition to Schedule 2 of the items specified in Article 2. The loading bays are for the use of goods vehicles loading and unloading certain goods during the hours between 8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
