**The Parking Places on Roads (Londonderry) (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 2013**

Made - - - - - *15th May 2013*

Coming into operation - - - - - *6th June 2013*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4) and 13(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in Article 2.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department, in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objections or other representations have been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places on Roads (Londonderry) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013 and shall come into operation on 6th June 2013.

Amendment

2. The Parking Places on Roads (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011^(d) shall be amended by the addition to the Schedule of the following items—

(a) S.I. 1999/283 (N.I. 1) Article 3(1)
(b) S.I. 1997/276 (N.I. 2)
(c) S.R. 1999 No. 481 Article 6(d) and Schedule 4 Part IV
(d) S.R. 2011 No. 193

- “4. Little James Street (west side) from a point 15 metres north of its junction with William Street for a distance of 90 metres in a northerly direction.
5. Shipquay Street (north-west side) from a point 21 metres north of its junction with The Diamond for a distance of 36 metres in a north-easterly direction.
6. Shipquay Street (north-west side) from a point 94 metres north of its junction with The Diamond for a distance of 42 metres in a north-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places on Roads (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011 (“the Order”) by the addition to the Schedule of the items specified in Article 2.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the roads.
