The County Court Rules Committee makes the following Rules in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 47 of the County Courts (Northern Ireland) Order  $1980(\mathbf{a})$ .

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

**1.** These Rules may be cited as the County Court (Amendment No.2) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2013 and shall come into operation on 17th June 2013.

#### Amendments to the County Court Rules (Northern Ireland) 1981(b).

2. In Form 19, for "£30,000" substitute "£15,000".

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

#### (This note is not part of the Rules)

These Rules amend Form 19 of the County Court Rules (Northern Ireland) 1981 (S.R. 1981 No. 225) to clarify that, where it exceeds £15,000, the value of the estate must be specified on the Form. The amendment corrects provision made in Rule 19 of the County Court (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2013 which indicated the requirement applied to estates valued over £30,000.
