**The Curran Street and Obins Street, Portadown (Abandonment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 2013**

Made - - - - *4th March 2013*

Coming into operation - *1st May 2013*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes to abandon the areas of road described in the Schedule as they are not necessary.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Curran Street and Obins Street, Portadown (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013 and shall come into operation on 1st May 2013.

Application

2. The areas of road described in the Schedule are abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned areas of road shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

SCHEDULE AREAS OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

Article 2

Three areas of road at Curran Street and Obins Street, Portadown totalling 443.1 square metres, consisting of:—

- (a) 225.5 square metres of footway and carriageway on the south side of Obins Street, commencing at a point on the eastern side of its eastern junction with Curran Street, and extending for 90 metres in a westerly direction;
- (b) 101.7 square metres of footway on the western side of Curran Street, commencing at a point 6 metres south-west of its eastern junction with Obins Street, and extending for 78 metres in a generally south-westerly direction; and
- (c) 115.9 square metres of carriageway on the south-west side of Curran Street, commencing at a point 111 metres south-west of its eastern junction with Obins Street, and extending for 33.4 metres in a generally westerly direction;

more particularly delineated in red and shown hatched on Map No. 10/1/21/12.
