# Superannuation (Maze/Long Kesh Development Corporation) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013

Made	-	28th March 2013
Coming into operation	-	22nd April 2013

The Department of Finance and Personnel makes the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 3(4) and (7) of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order  $1972(\mathbf{a})$  and now vested in it(**b**).

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Maze/Long Kesh Development Corporation) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013, shall come into operation on 22nd April 2013 and shall have effect from 10th September 2012.

#### Addition to list of employments

**2.** There shall be added to the kinds of employment listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972, employment by the Maze/Long Kesh Development Corporation(c).
