SCHEDULE 1

CLASSIFICATION: CERTIFICATION CONDITIONS

- 4. Seed potatoes shall not be classified-
 - (a) as Pre-basic TC seed potatoes, if the immediately succeeding crop produced from those potatoes is likely to contain—
 - (i) plants of another variety; or
 - (ii) virus affected plants;
 - (b) as Pre-basic 1 or Pre-basic 2 seed potatoes, if, in relation to the immediately succeeding crop produced from those potatoes, the number of growing plants which—
 - (i) deviate from variety and type, is likely to exceed 0.01% of the total number of plants in that crop; or
 - (ii) show symptoms of mild or severe virus diseases attributable to infection in the mother crop, is likely to exceed 0.01% of that total number; or
 - (c) as basic seed potatoes, if, in relation to the immediately succeeding crop produced from those potatoes, the number of growing plants which—
 - (i) deviate from variety, is likely to exceed 0.1% of the total number of plants in that crop;
 - (ii) deviate from variety and type, is likely to exceed 0.25% of that total number; or
 - (iii) show symptoms of mild or severe virus diseases attributable to infection in the mother crop, is likely to exceed 4% of that total number.
