**The Regulation of Care (Scotland) Act
2001 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2001**

Made - - - - 7th September 2001

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 81(2) of the Regulation of Care (Scotland) Act 2001(1), hereby make the following Order:

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Care (Scotland) Act 2001 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2001.

Commencement of provisions

2.—(1) The following provisions of the Regulation of Care (Scotland) Act 2001 shall come into force on 1st October 2001:—

- (a) sections 5(1) and (2), 6, 24(1), 29, 30, 53 to 55, 63 to 65, 67 and 71;
- (b) section 79, so far as relating to the provisions in Schedule 3 specified in paragraph (d) below;
- (c) in section 80, subsections (3) and (4); and
- (d) in schedule 3, paragraphs 20 and 23(7).

(2) Section 70 of the Regulation of Care (Scotland) Act 2001 shall come into force on 20th December 2001.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
