The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(1) and by section 36(1), (2)(h) and (3)(d) of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1986(2) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:
