**The Smoking, Health and Social Care (Scotland)
Act 2005 (Commencement No. 4) Order 2006**

Citation and interpretation

1. This Order may be cited as the Smoking, Health and Social Care (Scotland) Act 2005 (Commencement No. 4) Order 2006.
2. In this Order—
 - “the Act” means the Smoking, Health and Social Care (Scotland) Act 2005; and
 - “the 1978 Act” means the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978⁽¹⁾.

Appointed days

3. The days appointed for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Act are:—
 - (a) 7th March 2006 for the provisions of the Act specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order but, where a particular purpose is specified in column 3 of that Schedule in relation to that provision, that provision shall only come into force for the purpose specified in that column; and
 - (b) 1st April 2006 for the provisions of the Act specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order, in so far as those provisions are not already in force, but, where a particular purpose is specified in column 3 of that Schedule in relation to that provision, that provision shall only come into force for the purpose specified in that column.
