**The Planning etc. (Scotland) Act 2006 (Development Planning) (Saving Provisions) Order 2008**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 58(1) of the Planning etc. (Scotland) Act 2006<sup>(1)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Planning etc. (Scotland) Act 2006 (Development Planning) (Saving Provisions) Order 2008 and comes into force on 19th May 2008.

**Saving provision**

2. Notwithstanding the commencement of section 2 of the Planning etc. (Scotland) Act 2006 for certain purposes by the Planning etc. (Scotland) Act 2006 (Commencement No. 3) Order 2008<sup>(2)</sup> the provisions of Part 2 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997<sup>(3)</sup> shall continue in full force and effect.

This Order preserves Part 2 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 (“the 1997 Act”) in full force and effect notwithstanding the commencement for certain purposes of section 2 of the Planning etc. (Scotland) Act 2006 (“the 2006 Act”). Section 2 of the 2006 Act substitutes a new Part 2 for Part 2 of the 1997 Act.
