The Scallops (Luce Bay) (Prohibition of Fishing) Order 2010

Enforcement

4.—(1) For the purposes of the enforcement of this Order, the powers that may be exercised by any British sea-fishery officer by virtue of section 15(3) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967 in relation to any fishing boat within Luce Bay to which the prohibition imposed by article 3 of this Order applies are the powers of a British sea-fishery officer under section 8(2) to (4) of the Sea Fisheries Act 1968⁽¹⁾.

(2) For the purposes mentioned in paragraph (1)—

- (a) section 8(3) of the Sea Fisheries Act 1968 shall be construed as if article 3 of this Order were one of the provisions mentioned in section 8(1) of that Act, and
- (b) section 8(4) of that Act shall be construed as if article 3 of this Order were one of the provisions mentioned in that subsection and the reference to “British fishery limits” shall be construed as a reference to Luce Bay.
