MODIFICATIONS RELATING TO JOINT INSPECTIONS

Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 (Exclusions and Exceptions) (Scotland) Order 2003

1. In paragraph 19 of Part 2 of Schedule 4 to the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 (Exclusions and Exceptions) (Scotland) Order 2003⁽¹⁾ (excepted offices and employments), for “section 1” to “Act 2006” substitute “section 115 of the Public Services Reform (Scotland) Act 2010”.
