ROADS AND BRIDGES

The A876 Trunk Road (Clackmannanshire Bridge) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made
Coming into force

12th September 2011
24th September 2011

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 62(1) of the Road (Scotland) Act 1984^(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 62(1) of that Act, they are of the opinion that considerations of public safety require that traffic should be prohibited on the length of road specified in the Schedule to Order.

They have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A876 Trunk Road (Clackmannanshire Bridge) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011, comes into force at 2000 hours on 24th September 2011 and ceases to have effect at 1300 hours on 25th September 2011.

Temporary prohibition of use of a road

2. No person shall pass on foot or use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of that length of road by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a).

Alternative route

3. The alternative route for traffic during the prohibition will be via the Kincardine Bridge, through the town of Kincardine and onto the A977 Longannet Roundabout – Gartarry Roundabout Trunk Road and will be signposted.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

That length of the M876/A876 Dennyloanhead – Kilbagie Roundabout Trunk Road being the northbound and southbound carriageways of the Clackmannanshire Bridge from the Higgens Neuk Roundabout to the Kilbagie Roundabout, a distance of 4.2 kilometres, or thereby.
