**The Charities References in Documents
(Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2011**

Made - - - - *15th December 2011*
Laid before the Scottish
Parliament - - - - *20th December 2011*
Coming into force - - *1st May 2012*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Charities References in Documents (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2011 and come into force on 1st May 2012.

Amendment of the Charities References in Documents (Scotland) Regulations 2007

2. At the end of regulation 4(k) (specified documents) of the Charities References in Documents (Scotland) Regulations 2007⁽²⁾ insert—

“;

(l) the home web page on a website operated by or on behalf of the charity”.
