### MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

**69 Criminal proceedings in ecclesiastical courts to be taken only in accordance with this Measure.**

No proceedings by way of a criminal suit, other than those authorised by [<sup>F1</sup> Part VI] of this Measure, shall be instituted against a person <sup>F2</sup>... in the Court of Ecclesiastical Causes Reserved, and no proceedings so authorised shall be instituted except in accordance with [<sup>F3</sup> that Part] of this Measure:
