1938 No. 3 1 and 2 Geo 6

## 7 Notice of application of moneys.

[<sup>F1</sup>The Church Commissioners] shall give the prescribed notice to the [<sup>F2</sup>registered]patron of the benefice affected and to the parochial church council of the parish within which that benefice is situate of any proposed application and disposition of moneys under paragraph (ii) of subsection one of section five of this Measure, and shall consider any representations made by such [<sup>F2</sup>registered]patron or council with regard to such application and disposition.
