The Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 2010

PART 2

SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS AND PENSIONS

Rates of age addition

14.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), in regulation 10(2) of the Social Security (Incapacity Benefit) Regulations 1994⁽¹⁾ (increase in rate of incapacity benefit where beneficiary is under prescribed age on the qualifying date)—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) for “£15.65” substitute “£18.65”; and
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b) for “£6.55” substitute “£9.35”.

(2) In the case of a claimant entitled to long-term incapacity benefit, the sums specified in regulation 10(2)(a) and (b)⁽²⁾ shall be reduced to “£15.00” and “£5.80” respectively.
