In accordance with section 53(3) of that Act, a draft of this instrument was laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

Citation, commencement and application

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Mesothelioma Lump Sum Payments (Conditions and Amounts) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 1st April 2012.
 - (2) Regulation 2(a) applies only in relation to a person—
 - (a) first diagnosed with mesothelioma on or after 1st April 2012; or
 - (b) where the date of their first diagnosis with mesothelioma is unknown, if a claim is made by that person on or after 1st April 2012.
- (3) Regulation 2(b) applies only in relation to the dependant of a person who dies on or after 1st April 2012.
