**The Access to Justice Act 1999  
(Destination of Appeals) Order 2016**

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

**2.** In this Order—

“the 1981 Act” means the Senior Courts Act 1981(1);

“the 1984 Act” means the County Courts Act 1984(2);

“the Companies Acts” means the Companies Act 1985(3), the Companies Act 1989(4) and the Companies Act 2006(5);

“decision” includes any judgment, order or direction of the High Court or the county court;

“enterprise judge” has the meaning assigned to it by rule 63.1(2)(h) of the Civil Procedure Rules 1998(6);

“family proceedings” has the meaning assigned to it by section 32 of the Matrimonial and Family Proceedings Act 1984(7); and

“a judge of the county court” has the meaning assigned to it by section 5 of the 1984 Act(8).
