



CHAPTER cxlix.

An Act to confirm a Scheme of the Charity Commissioners A.D. 1909.
for the management of (1) The Charity consisting of
the proceeds of sale of Hope English Baptist Chapel
in Queen Street in the township of Bridgend in the
parish of Coity in the county of Glamorgan and (2)
The Charity consisting of the Hope English Baptist
Sunday Schoolroom in Queen Street aforesaid.

WHEREAS the Charity Commissioners for England and
Wales in their report to His Majesty of their proceedings
during the year one thousand nine hundred and eight have
reported that they have approved and certified a scheme for the
management of—

- (1) The charity consisting of the Hope English Baptist
Chapel in Queen Street in the township of Bridgend
in the parish of Coity in the county of Glamorgan
comprised in a scheme of the said Commissioners of
the thirteenth day of October one thousand nine
hundred and eight; and
- (2) The charity consisting of the Hope English Baptist
Sunday Schoolroom in Queen Street aforesaid com-
prised in a scheme of the said Commissioners of the
sixteenth day of October one thousand nine hundred
and eight:

And whereas it is expedient that the scheme as the same is
fully set out and defined in the schedule to this Act should be
confirmed:

Chapel Scheme Confirmation Act, 1909.

A.D. 1909. Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Confirmation of scheme. **1.** The said scheme is hereby confirmed Provided always that nothing in this Act or in the said scheme shall be held to interfere with the ordinary jurisdiction over endowed charities now exerciseable or hereafter to become exerciseable by the High Court of Justice and the Charity Commissioners.

Short title. **2.** This Act may be cited as the Bridgend Hope English Baptist Chapel Scheme Confirmation Act 1909.

SCHEDULE.

A.D. 1909.

Scheme for the Application or Management of—

- (1) *The Charity consisting of the Proceeds of Sale of the Hope English Baptist Chapel in Queen Street in the Township of Bridgend in the Parish of Coity in the County of Glamorgan comprised in a Scheme of the Charity Commissioners of the 13th October 1908; and*
- (2) *The Charity consisting of the Hope English Baptist Sunday Schoolroom in Queen Street aforesaid comprised in a Scheme of the said Commissioners of the 16th October 1908.*

1. The Trustees of the above-mentioned charity numbered 1 may apply a sufficient sum out of the proceeds derived from the sale authorised by the above-mentioned scheme of the 13th October 1908 of the above-mentioned Hope English Baptist Chapel in the payment of—

- (A) Their proper expenses incidental to the establishment of the said scheme;
- (B) Their proper expenses attending the said sale; and
- (C) One equal moiety of the proper expenses incidental to the approval certification and confirmation of this scheme:

Provided that an account of the said expenses shall first be approved by the Charity Commissioners and may apply the balance of the said proceeds towards the discharge of the indebtedness subsisting in connexion with the new Chapel and Sunday School buildings in Coity Street and Station Road Bridgend comprised in an indenture of lease dated the 30th July 1907.

2. The Trustees of the above-mentioned charity numbered (2) may apply a sufficient sum out of the rent to be received under any such letting of the above-mentioned Hope English Baptist Sunday Schoolroom as is referred to in the above-mentioned scheme of the 16th October 1908 in the payment of—

- (A) Their proper expenses incidental to the establishment of the last-mentioned scheme; and
- (B) One equal moiety of the proper expenses incidental to the approval certification and confirmation of this scheme:

Provided that an account of the said expenses shall first be approved as aforesaid and may apply the balance of the said rent in the payment

A.D. 1909. of the ground rent and other outgoings payable by them in respect of such Sunday Schoolroom and subject thereto in or towards the payment of the interest due in respect of any mortgage or charge for the time being subsisting in respect of the aforesaid new Chapel and Sunday School buildings or otherwise for such purposes connected with the repair maintenance or user of those buildings as the Trustees last aforesaid shall from time to time think proper.

3. The Charity Commissioners may from time to time in the exercise of their ordinary jurisdiction establish schemes for the alteration of any of the provisions of this scheme as if those provisions had been made by the founder in the case of a charity having a founder.
