An Act for authorizing the Removal of the Infirmary of the County of *Kildare* from the Town of *Kildare* to the Town of *Naas*. [2d June 1810.]

WHEREAS, by an Act made in the Parliament of *Ireland*, in the Fifth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for erecting and establishing Public Infirmaries or Hospitals in this Kingdom*, it was amongst other Things enacted, That the Infirmary or Hospital for the County of *Kildare* should be erected and established in the Town of *Kildare*, in that County : And whereas it has been found by Experience that the said Town of *Kildare* is, from the Want of Water there, and from other Circumstances, highly inconvenient for the Situation of an Hospital or Infirmary : be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this Act any Infirmary or Hospital for the said County of *Kildare*, which at any Time before the passing of this Act may have been erected or established in the said Town of *Kildare*, may be removed to the Town of *Naas*, in the said County of *Kildare*, or within One Mile of the Court House thereof, and that an Infirmary or Hospital for the said County of *Kildare* may be erected and established in the said Town of *Naas*, instead of being erected or established in the said Town of *Kildare*, any Thing in the said recited Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

Kildare County Infirmary may be removed to the Town of Naas.

II. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That the Infirmary or Hospital for the said County of *Kildare*, which may be so removed to, or erected and established in the said Town of *Naas*, shall be erected and established, and shall be managed and conducted in such Manner, and under such Rules, Regulations, and Restrictions, in all Respects, as by the said herein-before recited Act, or any Act or Acts for amending the same are directed or provided with respect to the Infirmary or Hospital, directed

Such Infirmary shall be subject to Regulation of recited Act.

by the said recited Act to be erected and established in the Town of *Kildare*: And that in Case any such Infirmary or Hospital shall be removed to or erected and established in the said Town of *Naas*, pursuant to the Provisions of this Act, no such Hospital or Infirmary shall be continued, or shall hereafter be erected and established in the said Town of *Kildare*.

Expence of Removal, and of this Act, may be raised by Grand Jury.

III. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Grand Jury of the said County of *Kildare*, at any Assizes after the passing of this Act, to present such Sum and Sums of Money as shall be necessary to defray the Expence of the Removal of such Infirmary or Hospital from the said Town of *Kildare* to the said Town of *Naas*: And also the Expences of the passing of this Act; and such Sum and Sums shall be raised and levied off the said County of *Kildare*, in such and the like Manner as any other Presentments, for the Benefit of such Infirmary or Hospital, may be raised and levied by any Act or Acts in force in *Ireland* at the Time of the passing of this Act.

Publick Act.

IV. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall be deemed and taken to be a publick Act, and shall be judicially taken Notice of as such by all Judges, Justices, and others whomsoever, without being specially pleaded.
