

# Tweed Fisheries Act 1857

1857 CHAPTER cxlviii 20 and 21 Vict

### LXVI Rubbish not to be placed in the River at or below High-water Mark.

Every Person who at any Time lays or places in or allows to fall into the River at or below High-water Mark any Coal, Cinders, Coal Ashes, Dirt, or Rubbish shall for every such Offence be liable to a Penalty not exceeding  $[^{F1}\pounds 25][^{F1}$ level 1 on the standard scale].
