



CHAPTER 9.

An Act to apply the Documentary Evidence Acts to the A.D. 1895. Board of Agriculture. [14th May 1895.]

E it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. The Documentary Evidence Act, 1868, as amended by the Application Documentary Evidence Act, 1882, shall apply to the Board of of Documentary Agriculture in like manner as if that Board were mentioned in the Evidence first column of the schedule to the first-mentioned Act, and the Acts to President or any member of the Board, or the Secretary of Board of the Board, or any person authorised by the President to get on Agriculture. the Board, or any person authorised by the President to act on 31 & 32 Vict. behalf of the Secretary of the Board, were mentioned in the second c. 37. column of that schedule, and as if the regulations referred to in 45 & 46 Vict. those Acts included any document issued by the Board.
- 2. This Act may be cited as the Documentary Evidence Act, Short title. 1895, and the Documentary Evidence Act, 1868, and the Documentary Evidence Act, 1882, and this Act may be cited collectively as the Documentary Evidence Acts, 1868 to 1895.
