



## CHAPTER 6.

An Act to amend the Military Lands Act, 1892. [8th April 1897.]

and by the authority of the same, as follows:

A.D. 1897.

BE it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled,

1. The powers of a volunteer corps to borrow, and of the Public Amendment Works Loan Commissioners to lend, shall extend to the borrowing of law as to and lending of such money as may be required for the purchase, powers. erection, construction, alteration, or enlargement of any building or permanent work for the purposes of a volunteer corps, or for the repayment of a loan raised for any such purpose.

2. This Act shall be construed as part of the Military Lands Short title and Act, 1892, and may be cited as the Military Lands Act, 1897, and construction. the Military Lands Act, 1892, and this Act may be cited together 55 & 56 Vict. as the Military Lands Acts, 1892 and 1897.
