## CHAPTER 14.

An Act to amend the Protection of Animals A.D. 1921. [1st July 1921.] Act, 1911.

DE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:--

1. The first section of the Protection of Animals Act, 1911, subsection (3), paragraph (b), shall be amended of Protection by the addition thereto of the following words:—

Amendment of Animals Act, 1911.

"and a captive animal shall not be deemed to be coursed or hunted within the meaning of this c. 27. s. 1. subsection if it is coursed or hunted in an enclosed subs. 3 (b). space from which it has no reasonable chance of escape."
