###### *Applications, etc.*

- 2 A registration certificate shall be surrendered by lodging with the [<sup>F1</sup>designated officer for] the justices a notice of surrender, together with the certificate and such number of additional copies of the notice as is required under paragraph 4 of this Schedule.
