## **1964 CHAPTER 73**

An Act to amend the British North America Act 1867. [31st July 1964]

HEREAS the Senate and House of Commons of Canada in Parliament assembled have submitted an Address to Her Majesty praying that Her Majesty may graciously be pleased to cause a measure to be laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom for the enactment of the provisions hereinafter set forth:

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Section 94A of the British North America Act 1867 is Amendment hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"" as to legislation respecting

"Legislation 94A. The Parliament of Canada may make laws in old age relation to old age pensions and supplementary pensions. benefits, including survivors' and disability benefits 30 & 31 Vict. irrespective of age, but no such law shall affect the operation of any law present or future of a provincial legislature in relation to any such matter."

2. This Act may be cited as the British North America Act Short title 1964; and the British North America Acts 1867 to 1960 and this and citation. Act may be cited together as the British North America Acts 1867 to 1964.
