12 Amendment of New Forest Act 1877.

Section 25 of the New Forest Act 1877 shall have effect as if for the words “two pounds” there were substituted the words “ten pounds” and as if the words “or in the case of a continuing offence the sum of ten shillings for every day during which such offence is continued after conviction for the first offence” were omitted therefrom.
