	The enactments mentioned in the first column of Part II of Schedule 3 to this Ac (which specify fees or maximum fees for licences, certificates or permits to which those enactments relate or for registration under those enactments) may be amended by an order made by the Minister specified in relation to the enactment in question in the second column of the said Part II, so as to vary any sum specified by that enactmen or so as to provide that any sum payable under that enactment shall cease to be so payable; and an order under this subsection may be limited to such cases as may be specified by the order and may make different provision for different cases specified by the order.
