TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS AS TO VALUATION ACCORDING TO TONE OF LIST.

- 2 Where a further proposal for the alteration of the valuation list in resoect of a hereditament has been served on the valuation officer by any other person before the end of March 1967 but is not expressed to be made on the ground specified in paragraph 1(b) of this Schedule, and that person gives or has given, either before or within one month after the settlement of the further proposal, notice in writing to the valuation officer of his intention to make a further proposal in respect of the hereditament on that ground, any such further proposal made by that person which—
 - (a) is expressed to be made on that ground only ; and
 - (b) is or was served within one month after the service of the notice,

shall be treated for the purposes of paragraph 1 of this Schedule as if it had been served before the end of March 1967.
