



Statute Law (Repeals) Act 1969

1969 CHAPTER 52

5 Provisions relating to Northern Ireland.

- (1) The following provisions of this Act, that is to say, sections 2 to 4, ^{F1} . . . shall not extend to Northern Ireland; ^{F2} . . .
- (2) Save as expressly provided by subsection (1) above, this Act extends to Northern Ireland and shall, as respects matters within the powers of the Parliament of Northern Ireland, be subject to alteration by that Parliament as if it had been an Act passed before the day appointed for the purposes of section 6 of the ^{M1}Government of Ireland Act 1920.
- (3) The repeal by this Act of any enactment mentioned in Part II of the Schedule to this Act shall not affect the continued operation of section 20 of the ^{M2}Irish Church Act 1869.
