ENFORCEMENT OF DEBT

Provisions restricting sanction of imprisonment

11 Restriction on power of committal under Debtors Act 1869 (c. 62).

The jurisdiction given by section 5 of the Debtors Act 1869 to commit to prison a person who makes default in payment of a debt, or instalment of a debt, due from him in pursuance of an order or judgment shall be exercisable only—

- (a) by the High Court in respect of a High Court maintenance order; ^{F1}...
- (b) by [^{F2}the county court][^{F3}in respect of a judgment]or order which is enforceable by a court in England and Wales and is for the payment of any of the taxes, contributions [^{F4}premiums] or liabilities specified in Schedule 4 to this Act.[^{F5}; and
- (c) by the family court in respect of a High Court or family court maintenance order.]
