

1970 CHAPTER 56

An Act to make further provision with respect to the Civil Contingencies Fund. [17th December, 1970]

B^E IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1.—(1) It is hereby declared that the services in relation to Fund to be which advances can be made out of the Civil Contingencies Fund known as include navy, army and air services; and accordingly that Fund Fund. shall as from the commencement of this Act be known as the Contingencies Fund.

(2) Any reference in any other enactment to the Civil Contingencies Fund shall be construed as a reference to the Contingencies Fund.

2. In section 1(3) of the Miscellaneous Financial Provisions Increase in Act 1955 as amended by section 1 of the Miscellaneous Financial capital of Provisions Act 1968 (whereby the capital of the said Fund, Fund. including the permanent capital, was limited to £125 million or 1955 c. 6 such lower amount as the Treasury may by order direct), for the (4 & 5 Eliz. 2.). words "£125 million" there shall be substituted the words 1968 c. 75. "£200 million".

3.--(1) This Act may be cited as the Contingencies Fund Short title Act 1970.

(2) This Act shall come into operation at the end of the period ment. of one month beginning with the day on which it is passed.
