	(1) The council of a borough shall have power to appoint a person to be honorary recorder of the borough.

	(3) A person shall not be qualified to hold office as an honorary recorder of a borough Figure 2 unless he is a Circuit judge or Recorder (that is to say a Recorder appointed under this Act): Provided that this subsection shall not apply to a borough which immediately before the appointed day— (a) had power by charter to appoint a recorder of the borough, and
	(b) did not have a separate court of quarter sessions.
