Criminal Justice Act 1967

- 48 In the ^{M1}Criminal Justice Act 1967—
- (a) in all places where there occurs a reference to a court of assize or quarter sessions (sections . . . ^{F1} 56(1)(3)(5)(8)(11), 62(10) . . . ^{F1} and in Schedule 6 paragraphs 2, 14, 16, 21(c)) there shall be substituted a reference to the Crown Court.
- (b) in all places where there occurs a reference to a court of quarter sessions (sections 20, ^{F2} . . . 56 . . . ^{F3} (6), 62(6)(7), . . . ^{F4} and in Schedule 6 paragraph 1) there shall be substituted a reference to the Crown Court.
