SCHEDULE 13

ADJUSTMENT OF CLAIM HOLDINGS

PART VI

SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

- Where in accordance with any of the provisions of this Schedule a part of the benefit of an established claim constitutes a separate claim holding, the interest in land to which that claim holding relates shall be taken to be an interest of the like character as the interest to which the established claim related.
- Where in accordance with any of the provisions of this Schedule a claim holding (in this paragraph referred to as "the parent holding") is to be treated as divided into two or more claim holdings, a person who was the holder of one of those holdings shall be treated as having been the holder thereof at any time when he was the holder of the parent holding.
- Expressions used in this Schedule and in Part VII of this Act have the same meanings in this Schedule as in that Part of this Act.
- In this Schedule "the holder", in relation to a claim holding, means the person for the time being entitled to the holding, and "the time of completion" means the time when, in accordance with section 127 of this Act, the adjustment of claim holdings is deemed to have been completed.
