# **1973 CHAPTER 18**

## PART IV

MISCELLANEOUS AND SUPPLEMENTAL

### 54 Consequential amendments and repeals.

(1) Subject to the provisions of Schedule 1 to this Act—

- (a) the enactments specified in Schedule 2 to this Act shall have effect subject to the amendments specified in that Schedule, being amendments consequential on the provisions of this Act or on enactments repealed by this Act; and

- (2) The amendment of any enactment by Schedule 2 to this Act shall not be taken as prejudicing the operation of [<sup>F2</sup>sections 16(1) and 17(2)(a) of the <sup>MI</sup>Interpretation Act 1978] (which relates to the effect of repeals).
