ENFORCEMENT

Price regulation, price marking and price range notices

- (1) Any person who contravenes an order under section F1... 4 F1... of this Act shall be guilty of an offence and liable—
 (a) on conviction on indictment, to a fine;
 (b) on summary conviction, to a fine not exceeding £400.
