1975 CHAPTER 2

An Act to make further provision with respect to awards and grants by local education authorities; to enable the Secretary of State to bestow awards on students in respect of their attendance at adult education colleges; and to increase the proportion of the expenditure incurred in the maintenance or provision of aided and special agreement schools that can be met by contributions or grants from the Secretary of State.

3 Contributions and grants for aided and special agreements schools.

In sections 102 and 103 of the Education Act 1944 and section 1(2) of the MI Education Act 1967 (contributions and grants by Secretary of State equal to or not exceeding four-fifths of certain expenses incurred in the maintenance or provision of aided and special agreement schools) for the words "four-fifths" there shall be inserted the words "85 per cent.".

5 Citation, interpretation, commencement and extent.

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Education Act 1975.
- (2) The Education Acts 1944 to 1973 and this Act may be cited together as the Education Acts 1944 to 1975.
- (3) Any reference in this Act to any enactment is a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

- (5) Nothing in section 3 above or in Part II of the Schedule to this Act affects contributions or grants in respect of expenditure on work which was begun before 6th November 1974 or on the provision of the site on which, or buildings to which, any such work was done.
