General

58 Amendments and extension of enactments, and repeal.

- (1) The enactments mentioned in Schedule 6 shall have effect subject to the respective amendments there specified (being amendments consequential on the provisions of this Act).
- (2) The following enactments, namely,—
 - (a) section 5(2)(a) of the ^{M1}Parliamentary Commissioner Act 1967;
 - ^{F1}(b)
 - ^{F2}(c)shall have effect in relation to the right of a person to make a complaint of unlawful discrimination under this Act as if it were such a right of appeal, reference or review as is mentioned in those enactments.
- (3) Section 20(1)(b) of the Northern Ireland Constitution Act 1973 is hereby repealed.
